Essential selection criteria:

- Broad operational knowledge & experience in the functions of an aviation organisation.
- Detailed knowledge of Flight Operations Legislation & requirements & its effect on day to day operations.
- Ability to analyse data and make informed decisions.
- Ability to monitor corrective actions and report on flight safety trends.
- Ability to perform safety audits and inspections of the flight operations department.
- Able to conduct investigation of incidents and co-ordinating investigations into incidents.
- Proven technical expertise to assist the Safety & Compliance department and other parts of the business on Flight Operations practices, polices & legislation.
- Ability to manage or have oversight of the FOQA Programme.
- Eligible to hold & maintain an Aviation Security Identification Card.
- Hold a valid Drivers License.
- Hold a valid passport without restrictions .
